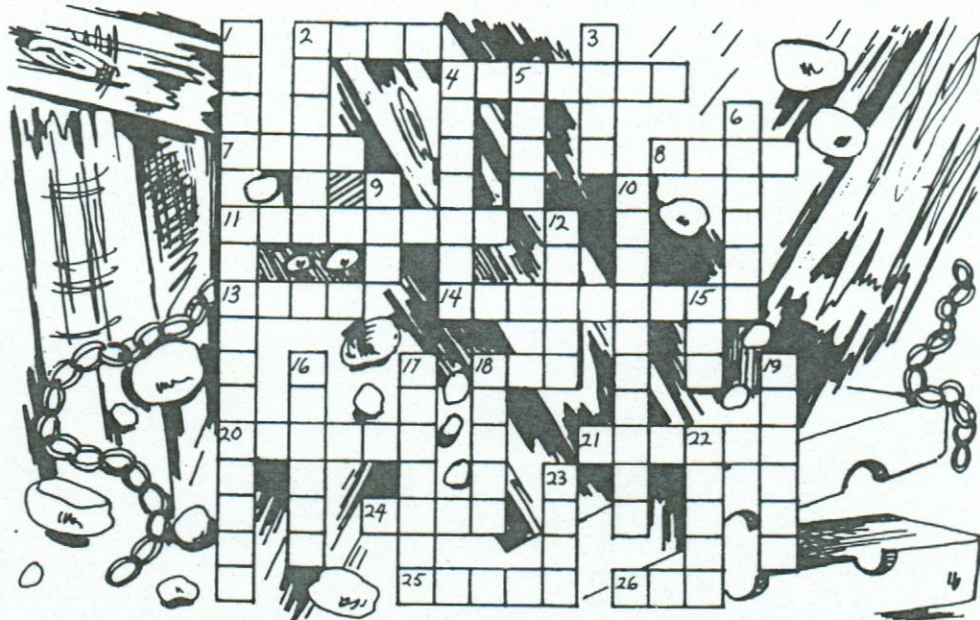

1. As Jesus went on His way a rich young ruler came running and kneeled before Him, saying: "Good Master, what should I do to inherit eternal life?"



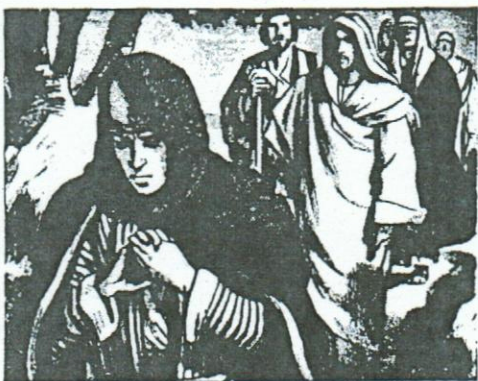
2. Jesus replied: "Why do you call Me good? Only God is good." Then He said: "You must keep the commandments."
