scissors

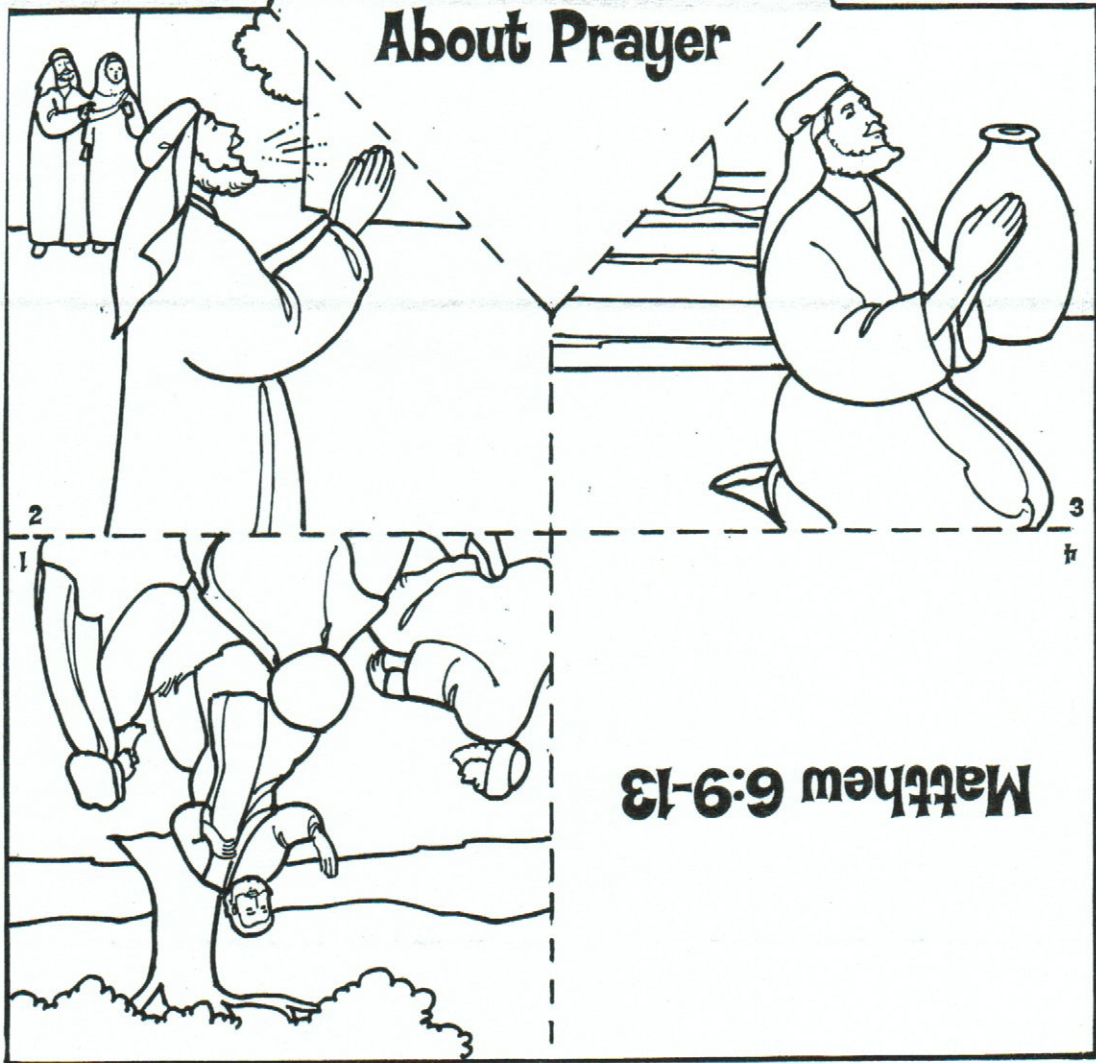
**Directions**

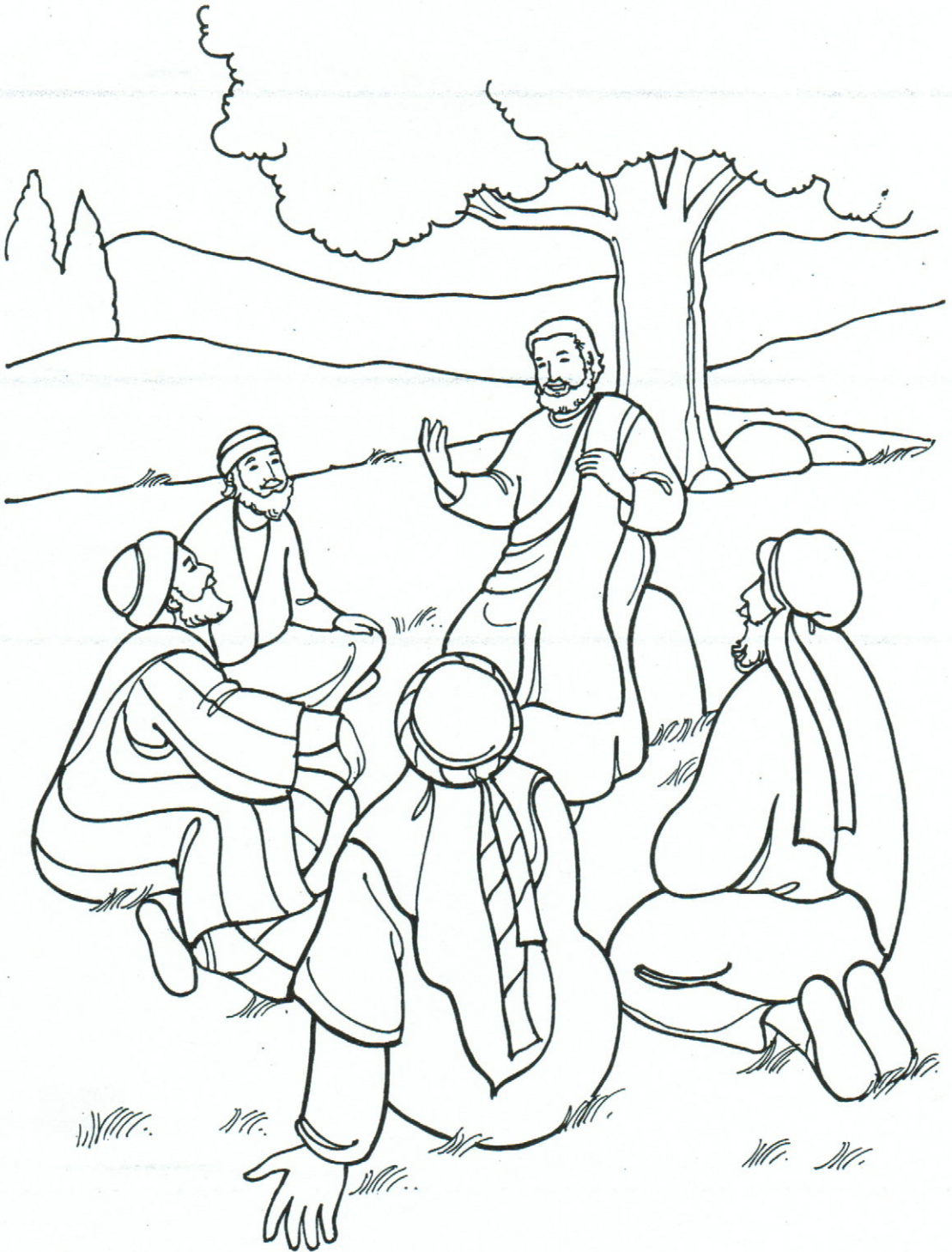
Color and cut out the pop-up card. Fold the card back along the horizontal dotted line so that the scenes are back to back. Fold the center piece down along the dotted lines and fold the card in half so that the pop-up piece is folded inside. Use the Prayer Pop-up Card to retell the story of Jesus teaching about prayer:

- 1) One day Jesus' was teaching about prayer.
- 2) Jesus said not to pray in public in order to get attention and not to use a lot of unnecessary words.
- 3) Jesus said to pray in a room behind a closed door and to trust that God knows what you need before you ask Him.
- 4) Jesus taught a model prayer to His followers in Matthew 6:9-13.

*Encourage students to find Matthew 6:9-13 in their Bibles and to memorize the prayer Jesus taught His disciples.*
