## Twenty-first Sunday ofter Pentecost Luke 8, 5-15



The ARCHANGEL MICHAEL and ALL HEAVENLY POWERS. A feast observed from the time of Constantine the Great. The Heavenly Powers are spirits sent to serve "those who inherit salvation" (Heb. 1:14). They are guardians and guides both to individual human beings and communities.

The choirs of angels are constantly participating in

the heavenly liturgy, surrounding God's altar and singing the Thrice-holy hymn. The Church places particular emphasis on two of these heavenly powers, MICHAEL, a name which means "who is like God" and GABRIEL, a name which means "power of God," because both are mentioned in Holy Scripture.

#### TROPARION (Tone 4)

LEADERS of the heavenly armies, although we are always unworthy, we beseech you that with your prayers you may encircle us with the protection of the wings of your angelic glory.


Watch over us as we bow low, and earnestly cry out to you: "Deliver us from trouble O Princes of the heavenly armies!"


#### KONTAKION (Tone 2)

Read Luke 8:4-8, 11-15. Finish the verse by matching the shapes at the top of the page with the same shapes below.






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
