



The escape from Egypt

God speaks to Moses


God spoke to Moses from a burning bush. He told him to ask Pharaoh to let the Israelites leave Egypt

Disasters and plagues

Pharaoh would not let the Israelites leave Egypt, so God sent many disasters to Egypt. There were sterrible diseases, storms, and darkness as well as plagues of flies, gnats, locusts, and frogs. Water was turned into blood.



The Passover is a feast that the Jews still celebrate today. It reminds them of the time when God "passed over" the houses of the Israelites when they were slaves in Egypt. During the Passover, Jews eat special bread that doesn't contain any yeast.



The worst disaster

Pharaoh still wouldn't listen, so God sent another disaster. One night the eldest son in every Egyptian family was killed, but God "passed over" the Israelite families, and their sons survived. At last, Pharaoh told Moses to leave Egypt.

The Israelites are chased

Moses led the Israelites to the edge of the sea where they camped. However, Pharaoh had changed his mind. His huge army was chasing the Israelites, who found themselves trapped between the Egyptian army and the sea.


