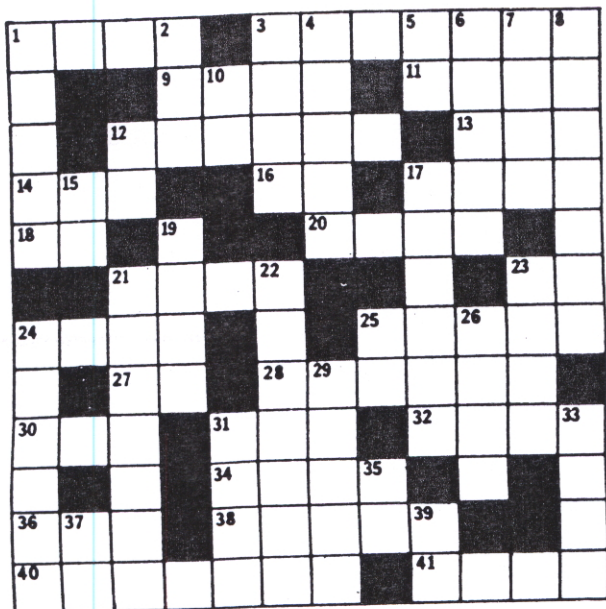

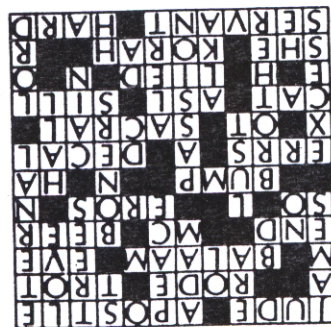

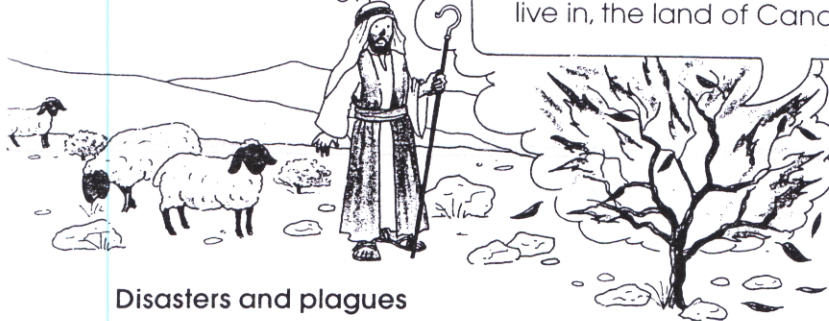
The escape from Egypt

Hundreds of years later, the Children of Israel had grown into a large nation. The Pharaoh at that time was cruel and forced them to work as slaves. God chose Moses to lead the Israelites out of Egypt to begin the long journey back to Canaan. This journey was called the Exodus.

God speaks to Moses

God spoke to Moses from a burning bush. He told him to ask Pharaoh to let the Israelites leave Egypt.

Disasters and plagues

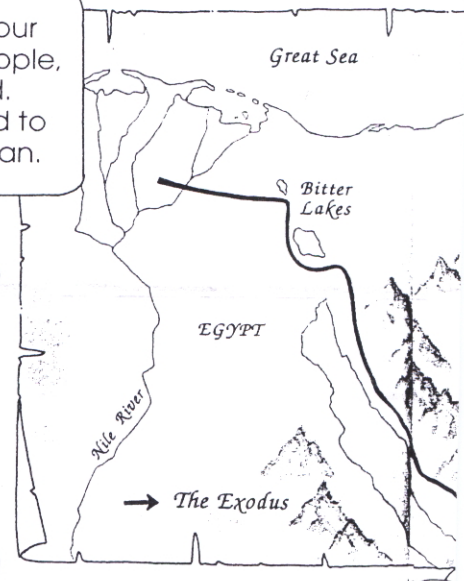
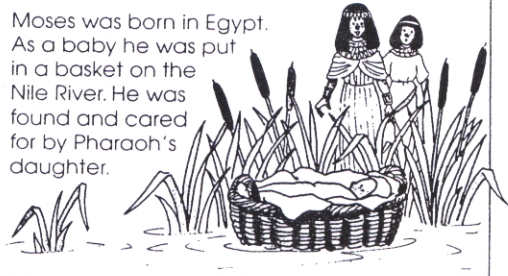
The worst disaster

Moses

The Passover

The Passover is a feast that the Jews still celebrate today. It reminds them of the time when God "passed over" the houses of the Israelites when they were slaves in Egypt. During the Passover, Jews eat special bread that doesn't contain any yeast.

Moses led the Israelites to the edge of the sea where they camped. However, Pharaoh had changed his mind. His huge army was chasing the Israelites, who found themselves trapped between the Egyptian army and the sea.



Don't be afraid. God will keep you safe. He will fight for you.

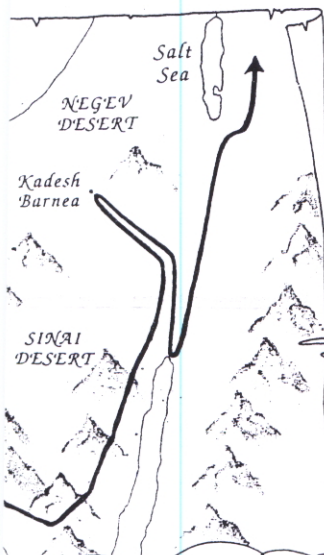
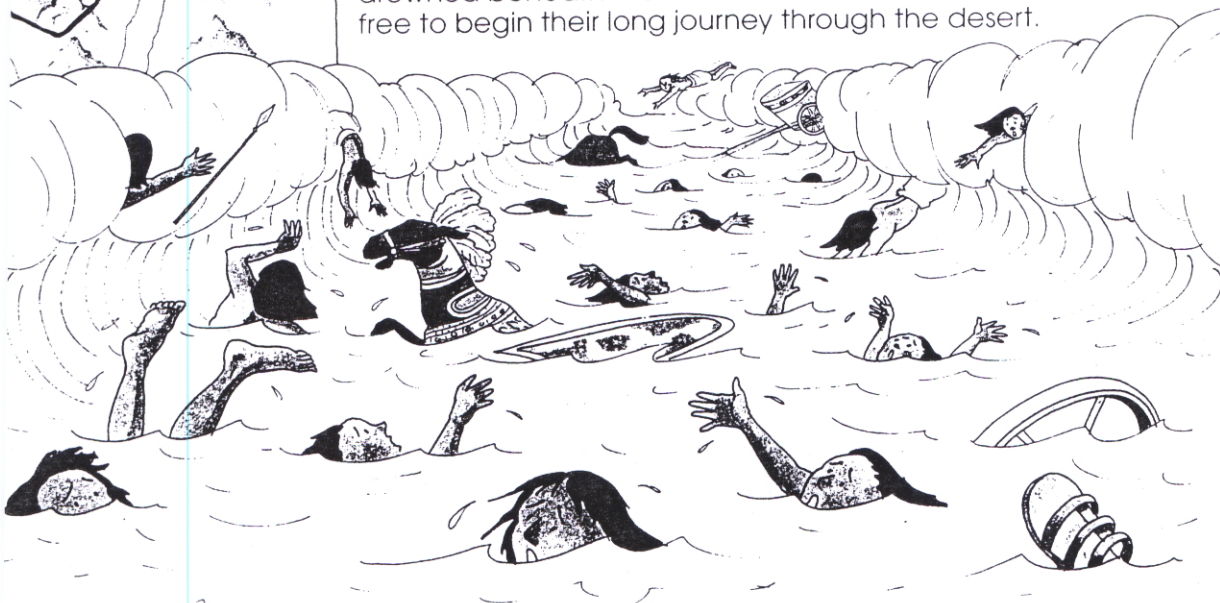
The sea divides
