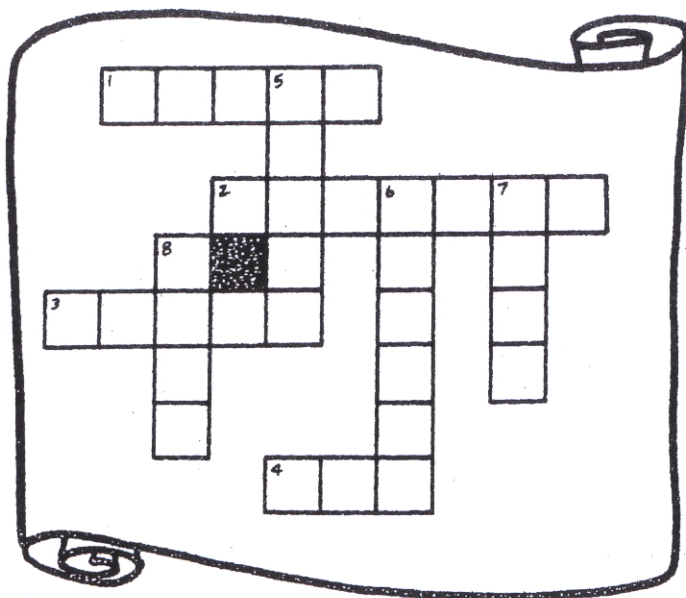

## THE WOMAN IN THE CROWD

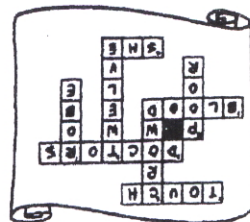

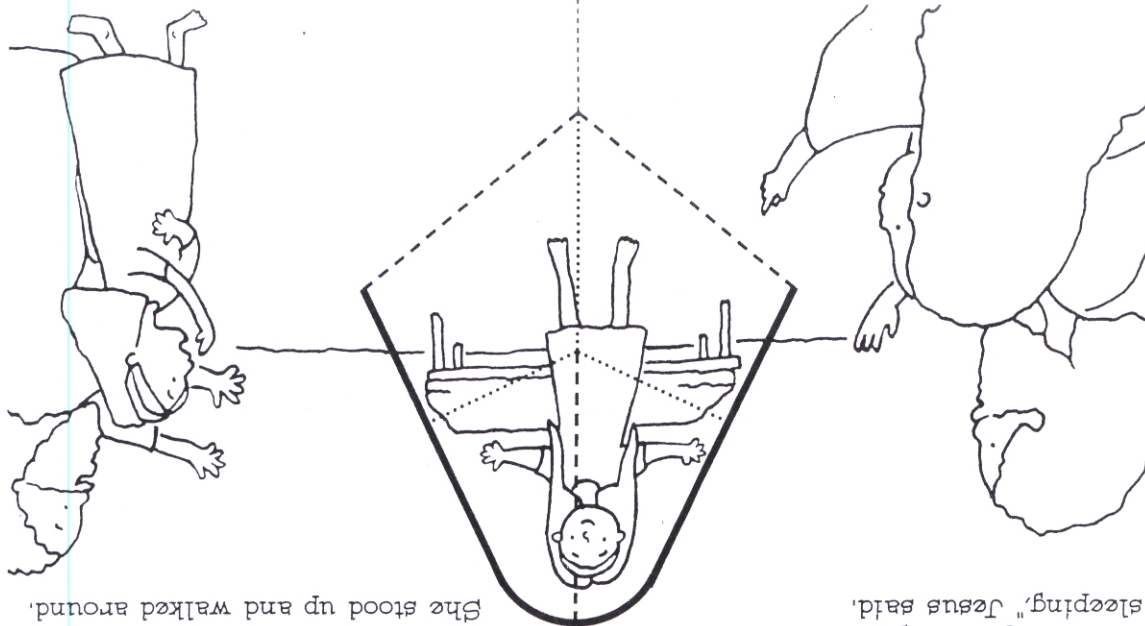
### ACROSS
